ARI serves the City of Savannah, Georgia as independent engineer for a 624-tpd waste-to-energy facility. The facility burns municipal solid waste collected from residences and businesses in the city and non-hazardous industrial waste from Chatham County, and surrounding areas.

ARI provides operations monitoring of the facility including monthly plant inspections and preparation of a report reviewing operating performance. ARI staff also summarize any contract negotiation issues, meet with regulatory agencies, and provide qualitative assessments.

ARI observes the annual performance testing that is conducted to demonstrate compliance with emissions limitations and ash testing. ARI reviews the performance test reports, annual and semiannual emissions reports, and ash characterization testing reports.

ARI also reviews plant staffing, plant improvements, preventive maintenance, and other critical issues of importance to the City of Savannah and the facility operator.
